Howard served on active duty in the Air Force, for 3 years, resigning in 1964, with the rank of 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant. He served at Altus, OK (577 Strategic Missile Squadron - Atlas F Missiles), often serving as Missile Combat Crew Deputy Commanders which involved thirty hour shifts in the missile launch control centers.

After leaving active duty in the Air Force, Howard worked in real estate. Tragically, he was shot and killed at a 7-Eleven store in Atlanta, GA on 27 June, 1997.
