Died – 23 April 2024 (age 84) at McKinney, TX. Buried at West Point.

Mick served on active duty in the Army (Artillery) for 4 years, resigning in 1965, with the rank of Captain. His first assignment was with the 6th Artillery in Gelnhausen, Germany including serving as a battery commander of a 155mm battery.

After leaving active duty in the Army, Mick had a successful career in the telecommunications and computer services industry. He worked with Southwest Bell Telephone Company (Distribution Plant Superintendent), AT&T (Manager, Business Installations), Southwest Bell North Texas (Assistant Vice President), AT&T (Vice President, Services Operations, Computer Systems), AT&T/NCR Corporation (Vice President, N&S America and then VP European Operations). Mick passed away on 23 April 2024, from pancreatic cancer.
