Bob served on active duty in the Army (Armor) for 20 years, retiring in 1981, with the rank of Lt. Colonel. His first assignment was with the 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment, 3ACR in Germany. He then served at Fort Knox, KY (11th Armored Cavalry Regiment, ACR), Vietnam (1st tour - 1/9 Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN), Ann Arbor, MI (Student, University of Michigan), Norfolk, VA (Student, Armed Forces Staff College, AFSC), Vietnam (2nd tour - U.S. Army Vietnam, USARV), Pentagon, VA (Office of the Chief of Research & Development, OCRD), Germany (Headquarters 2nd Armored Cavalry Regiment, Hq2ACR and Headquarters U.S. Army Europe, HqUSAREUR), Pentagon, VA (Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Research, Development & Acquisition, Department of the Army, ODCSRDA DA).

After leaving active duty in the Army, Bob had a successful career in defense contracting with Advanced Technology, Inc. (ATI) / Planning Research Corporation (PRC). Bob passed away on 25 February 2022.
