Military Awards – National Defense Service Medal.

Schooling – Unknown.

Family - Wife – Bill was not married.

Contact – Unknown.

Bill served on active duty with the Army (Infantry) for 2 plus years before his untimely death from an automobile accident in Germany on 11 August, 1963. He was a 1st Lieutenant. His first assignment was with the 19th Infantry in Germany. Bill was killed in an automobile accident at Schwabing, near Dachau, Germany.
