Let me start with some things I have learned in the past two days, in no particular order.

I had been curious about the info on one of Balik's obits about finishing in two years. A study of the Register of Graduates for the years leading up and after WW I is interesting. Here is what I found. 1914, 107 graduated on June 12; 1915, 164 graduated on June 12; 1916, 125 graduated on June 12 (President Wilson spoke); 1917, 139 graduated on April 20; 1917, 151 graduated on August 30 (These cadets entered as the Class of 1918 but graduated ten months early); 1918, 137 graduated on June 12 (These cadets entered as the Class of 1919 but graduated a year early.); 1918, 227 graduated on November 1 (These cadets entered as the Class of 1920, graduated over a year early as the War Emergency Course Class of November 1918); 1919, 284 graduated on June 11 (These cadets entered as the Class of 1921, graduated two and a half years early on Nov. 1918, then were called back as second lieutenants to complete classroom work. They then graduated on 11 June 1919 but maintained their 1921 crest.); 1920, 271 graduated on June 15 (From the outset, those cadets entering in June-September 1918 were designated members of the two-year Class of 1920.); 1921 (The "Orioles") 17 graduated on June 13 (These 17 members of the Class of 1921 elected to graduate at the end of their third academic year under the provisions of the Act of Congress of 30 March 1920. Due to the shortage of cadet uniforms, the cadets entering in November and December 1918 initially wore Army uniforms with an orange band on their campaign hats, thus the nickname "Orioles."); 1922, 102 graduated on June 13 (These were the rest of the "Orioles."); 1922, 30 graduated on June 14 (This was one day after the "Orioles and these 30 took advantage of the 1920 Act of Congress to graduate in three years.); 1923, 262 graduated on June 12 (Things were finally more normal.)

While researching Dale Hall I learned that he was from Kansas and was an outstanding basketball player while at West Point.
