Always ready to do a favor for a friend, Sandy's ambitions, love of life, passion for tennis, and Army background should give him a real head start in the Artillery.*

**Born** – 17 Feb. 1938 in Ancon, Panama (U.S. Canal Zone). Army brat. His father, Alexander Jr., USMA Class of 1934 and served in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Division in Europe during WWII.

**To USMA** – from El Paso, TX. Appointed from MI. Nickname – “Sandy”.

**Died** – 8 April. 2023 (age 85) at Lynchburg, VA. Buried at Arlington National Cemetery.

**Military Awards** – Bronze Star Medal, 2 Army Commendation Medals, Joint Service Commendation Medals, Legion of Merit.

**Schooling** – Command & General Staff College, CGSC, CPA, Certified Public Accountant and MBA Degree, Master of Business Administration from Lynchburg College, VA.

Sandy served on active duty in the Army (Artillery) for 20 years, retiring in 1981, with the rank of Lt. Colonel. His first assignment was with the 3/57<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery Brigade in Germany. He then served in Vietnam (1<sup>st</sup> tour – MACF during the Tet offensive), Fort Sill, OK (Staff & Faculty, Field Artillery School, FAS), Vietnam (2<sup>nd</sup> tour – Headquarters MACV during the NVA Easter offensive), Fort Dix, NJ (Staff & Faculty, NCO Academy), Fort Leavenworth, KS (Student, Command & General Staff College), Fort Jackson, SC (Staff & Faculty, Army Institute of Administration, AIA), Pentagon, VA (Office of the Assistant Chief of Staff AC, Department of the Army, OACSAC DA),

After leaving active duty in the Army, Sandy had a successful career in business as an investment manager. He took classes at Lynchburg College, VA and became a CPA and then an MBA Degree. He became a stockholder/owner of a financial planning firm (Huff, Stuart & Carlton). Sandy passed away on 8 April 2023.
