Dale served on active duty in the Army (Artillery) for 4 years, resigning in 1965, with the rank of Captain. His first assignment was with the 6th Special Forces Group (Green Berets) at Fort Bragg, NC, Okinawa and Vietnam (2 tours).

After leaving active duty in the Army, Dale had a successful career with the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA). He lived and travelled in Korea, Philippines and Israel before settling back in the U.S. where he formed his own construction company. Dale passed away on 26 February 2022.

Footnote – Dale was a collector of antiquities, a spinner of yarns, and made friends wherever he went. He loved fly-fishing and horseback riding, and enjoyed studying history and researching his Scottish lineage.
