Dave served on active duty in the Army (Signal Corps) for 14 years, resigning in 1975, with the rank of Major. His first assignment was with the 121st Signal Battalion. He then served in Hawaii (Office of the Commander in Chief, Pacific Command, CINCPAC and Headquarters, U.S. Army Pacific, USARPAC), Vietnam (first tour - Headquarters, 1st Signal Brigade), Ft. Monmouth, NJ (Signal Corps Advanced Course), Monterey, CA (Naval Post Graduate School), Vietnam (second tour – Headquarters, 1st Brigade and 24th Corps), (Army Combat Development Command, CDC).

After leaving active duty in the Army, Dave worked for a short period of time as a civilian employee with the Signal Corps. Dave passed away on 16 December 1976.
