Born – 10 Dec. 1938, Michigan.

Died – 23 July 1961 (age 22) at Matehuala, Mexico. Buried at Arlington National Cemetery.

Military Awards – National Defense Service Medal.

Schooling – Unknown.

Family – Wife – Sue Farrell Navarro. Married a week after graduation.

Roland served on active duty in the Army (Infantry) for 2 months, until his untimely death in 1961, with the rank of 2nd Lieutenant. He was assigned to the Overseas Replacement Station at Ft. Dix, NJ, probably headed for a tour in Germany. After his wedding to Sue Farrell a week after graduation, they headed for Mexico on their honeymoon in his Austin-Healey. Roland passed away on 23 July 1961, from an automobile accident in Matehuala, Mexico. Sue was badly injured, but eventually recovered.
