Scotty served on active duty in the Army (Artillery) for 22 years (including service in the Air Force prior to West Point), retiring in 1979, with the rank of Lt. Colonel. His first assignment was with the 9th Artillery and then 76th Artillery. Later he served at Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling, Washington, D.C. (Defense Intelligence Agency, DIA) and Fort Meade, MD (Army Intelligence Agency, ArIntAgcy).

After leaving active duty in the Army, Scotty had a successful business career with Consolidated Edison. Scotty passed away on 4 May 2020.
